



SAINT-ÉMILION GRAND CRU

The parcels of old vines are planted on the Figeac plateau, place called West Cheval Blanc, hilltop made up of poor gravel on blue clay.

Average age of the vines : 30 years

Manual harvesting

Fermentation in concrete tank (30 days)

Ageing in new French oak barrels

Vintage 2017

60% Merlot; 35% Cabernet Sauvignon; 5% Cabernet Franc

Production : 965 numbered bottles

Garnet to purple color. The wine proposes an expressive nose, of a great complexity. Morello cherries in brandy, plum, black-currant, black truffle, violet...

The mouth is soft and draped, the tannins fine and peppery. The final is of a rare elegance.
